- Check in at Registration on the 1st floor of the hospital when you arrive. You do not need to be fasting and are not required to have a driver for the consultation appointment.

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- Check in at Registration on the 1st Floor of the hospital when you arrive.
- You must have someone else drive you home following your procedure.
- You will need someone to stay with you for 24 hrs following your procedure.
- You may have clear liquids up to 2 hrs, light meals or milk up to 6 hrs and fatty meals or meat up to 8 hrs prior to your procedure time.
- You may take all of your medications as you normally would (except for blood thinners).
- The following blood thinners must be stopped for the time frame indicated prior to your procedure. Contact one of the numbers below if you are unable to stop any of the listed medications for the indicated time. You must obtain permission to hold you blood thinning medication from whomever prescribed it. **Do not stop the medication on your own.**
 - 24 hours - Lovenox (enoxaparin), Fragmin (daltaparin), Motrin/Advil (ibuprofen), ketoprofen, Voltaren (diclofenac), Indocin (indomethacin)
 - 2 days - Alieve (naproxen), Celecoxib (Celebrex), Clinoril (sulindac), Dolobid (diflunisal), Savaysa (edoxaban)
 - 3 days - 81 mg Aspirin, Coumadin (warfarin), Xarelto (rivaroxaban), Eliquis (apixaban), Pradaxa (dabigatran), Bevyxxa (betrixaban), Aggrenox (aspirin/dypyridamole), Arixtra (fondaparinux)
 - 5 days - 325 mg Aspirin, Plavix (clopidogrel), Brilinta (ticagrelor)
The following medications must be held for 5 days if they contain aspirin: Bufferin, Alka Seltzer, Anacin, Excedrin & Goody's BC Powder.
 - 7 days - Ticlid (ticlopidine), Effient (prasugrel)
 - 10 days - Mobic (meloxicam), Feldene (piroxicam), Relafen (nabumetone)

- If you were told that your procedure will involve the use of **general anesthesia** (use of a breathing tube), the Anesthesiology department requires the following medications to be held for the timeframe indicated.
 - 24 hours - Rybelsus (semaglutide), Victoza (liraglutide), Januvia (sitagliptin), Tradjenta (linagliptin), Onglyza (saxagliptin)
 - 4 days - Farxiga/Xigduo/Qtern (dapagliflozin), Jardiance/Synjardy/Glyxambi (empagliflozin), Invokana/Invokamet (canagliflozin), Steglatro (ertugliflozin), Brenzavvy (bexagliflozin), Inpefa (sotagliflozin)
 - 7 days - Ozempic/Wegovy (semaglutide), Mounjaro/Zepbound (tirzepatide), Saxenda (liraglutide), Byetta (exenatide), Trulicity (dulaglutide)
