- Rads that do procedure: Agrait (MA), Byra (BY), Carter (CA), Cohen (DC), Combs (JC), Edwards (JE), Howard (JH), Parsons (CP), Rezaei (AR), Roth (NR), Sherard (DS), Wood (CW)
- Need imaging/radiologist review: no
- Need H&P: yes updated within 30 days of procedure date (must include heart & lungs exam)
- Need to hold blood thinners: no
- Need to hold other meds: no
- Need to be NPO: yes (2 hrs for clear liquids, 6 hrs for light meals & dairy products, 8 hrs for fatty meals)
- Need a driver: yes
- Need bed in Short Stay / PACU: yes
- Arrival time: 2 hrs prior to appointment
- Need an IV: yes
- Need blood work: CBC with differential the day of procedure for all patients BMP the day of procedure (only in patients with renal disease)
- **Receive moderate sedation:** yes + local anesthesia
- Stay after procedure: 1 hr after procedure
- Bone marrow biopsies must be scheduled no later than 1 pm at <u>Riverside</u> hospital.
- Bone marrow biopsies must be scheduled no later than 10 am at Southside, Clay or St Johns hospitals.
