St Vincents Inpatient GI Fluoro Protocols

G/J-Tube Injection

- Order XR Gastric Tube Injection
- Contrast Omnipaque-300 or 350 (do not use Gastrografin or Gastroview)
- Position upright (preferred) or supine
- Images
 - #1 AP abdomen
 - ➤ Inject 50 mL contrast view tube.
 - Flush tube with at 20-50 mL water to prevent tube clogging.
 - #2 AP abdomen

Post Op Upper GI

- Order XR Upper GI Routine
- Contrast Omnipaque-300 or 350 (do not use Gastrografin or Gastroview)
- Position upright (preferred) or table reclined (just enough for patient to be stable on his/her feet)
- Images
 - #1 PA upper abdomen
 - #2 LPO upper abdomen (right side turned 45° towards image intensifier)
 - ➤ Have patient drink 50-100 mL contrast.
 - #3 PA upper abdomen
 - #4 LPO upper abdomen

Small Bowel Follow Through

- Order XR Small Bowel
- Contrast Omnipaque-300 or 350
- Position upright (preferred) or supine
- Images
 - #1 AP abdomen/pelvis
 - Administer 400 mL contrast via tube or by mouth.
 - > Stop if patient begins vomiting.
 - #2 AP abdomen/pelvis @ 30 minutes
 - #3 AP abdomen/pelvis @ 2 hours
 - Rad check to determine time points for additional images.
- Notes
 - Make sure gastric / G-tube is clamped prior to administering contrast.
 - Remind patient's nurse to not unclamp tube unless instructed by tech or ordering provider.
