- Once the new IR Needle Placement order is live, leave the following orders visible to Radiology in Department Order Entry but hide from everyone (including Radiology) in Cerner.
 - > IR Radiology Consultation (but rename IR Consult)
 - > IR Fluoro Up To One Hr (but rename IR Fluoro < 1 Hr)
 - > IR Fluoro More Than One Hr (but rename IR Fluoro > 1 Hr)
- Once the new IR Needle Placement order is live, hide the following orders from every (including Radiology) in both Cerner and Department Order Entry.
 - > Biopsy Transjugular
 - > IR Biopsy Transcatheter
 - > IR US Guidance Needle Place
 - > Transjugular Biopsy
