- Once the new IR and XR Venous Line Patency Check orders are live, hide the following orders from everyone (including Radiology) in both Cerner and Department Order Entry.

 - > IR Port/PICC Patency Check w/ Angio
 - > XR Port a Cath Injection
 - > Portacath Injection
 - > Portogram w/ Press
 - > Portogram w/o Press
 - > Injection Portacath
